KEY MESSAGES FOR HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS

• It's important to vaccinate our younger children against COVID-19 since COVID-19 hospitalizations among those under 19 years of age is highest among children aged 0-4.

More than 1,000 children under 5 years of age have been hospitalized from COVID-19.

Youth infection outcomes as of July 2, 2022 (Public Health Ontario)	
Population	Hospitalizations
0-4	1,068
5-11	258
12-19	472
Total	1,798

- Starting July 28, people can book an appointment for their children between 6 months and 5 years at a Halton Region community clinic at <u>halton.ca/COVIDvaccines</u>.
- People who previously had a COVID-19 infection can boost their protection against COVID-19 by getting their next eligible COVID-19 vaccine 2-3 months after symptoms started or testing positive.

HOW TO OFFER COVID-19 VACCINE IN YOUR PRACTICE

- Protect your eligible staff and patients by providing an easy option for COVID-19 vaccination.

- Email your completed <u>clinic readiness checklist</u> and <u>Memorandum of Understanding</u> to pharmacists@halton.ca.
- Complete the OntarioMD COVax Training and attend a Halton online onboarding session.
- Receive your COVax accounts and vaccine event information.
- Order COVID-19 vaccine online. You can order as little as one vial at a time.
